

Do Not Call Suppression Feature

You've asked us about Do Not Call lists, and we've listened. With our expanded DNC screening feature, you can choose to remove any numbers on any supported Do Not Call lists.

Internal admins for ZoomInfo can enable the Do Not Call Suppression toggle inside of Company Settings in the Admin Portal. Enabling Do Not Call Suppression masks phone numbers registered on any supported national Do Not Call registries for all users in your organization.

These lists allow consumers to self-register their numbers in order to lessen the amount of phone calls received on their personal phone numbers. Now, you can choose to filter those numbers out of your ZoomInfo access.

Additionally, only phone numbers can be on the Do Not Call list; the DNC does not apply to a person. In other words, just because a person has registered a phone number, that registration does not apply to other phone numbers they may have not registered.

By using ZoomInfo's DNC feature, numbers found on supported DNC lists will be masked from your instance of ZoomInfo across your entire active user base. They will not be available on contact profiles, list views, within advanced search, through our Enrich product, or through our integrations.
